### Danger

If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. In case of fire: Use dry chemicals, CO<sub>2</sub>, water spray or alcohol-resistant foam to extinguish. Store in a well ventilated place. Keep cool. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container in conformance with State, Local, and Federal regulations.
